José De Gregorio is Full Professor and Dean of the School of Economics and Business of Universidad de Chile. He is also nonresident senior fellow at the Peterson Institute for International Economics. He was President of the Central Bank of Chile from 2007 until 2011, after being Vice-President from 2003, and member of the Board from 2001. During 2000 and 2001, he was Minister of Economy, Mining and Energy. He has a degree in civil engineering and a master's degree in engineering from the University of Chile. He obtained a Ph.D. in Economics from MIT in 1990. He has published four books, including *IMF Reform: The Unfinished Agenda* (co-authors: B. Eichengreen, C. Wyplosz y T. Ito, 2018) and *How Latin America Weathered the Global Financial Crisis* (PIIE, 2014). He is also the author of more than one hundred articles in international academic journals and books on macroeconomics and international finance.
